The context of the intervention

Indeed, the social intervention sector has become a subcontractor of States missions that are somewhat in escheat. This States missions no longer regulate the economy and no longer manage or no longer wish to bring the social policy corrective elements that were brought out some 30 years ago. Associations are then in a fragile situation compared to a financing system that can stop depending on the programs evaluation, the calls for projects and the competition between project leaders. These models challenge the very meaning of the social intervention by positioning it in the field of competition and economic performance. The commodification process reinforces social inequalities.

A few words about the clinic at La Borde

Clinique de Laborde (SE Clinique de Cour-Cheverny) was founded in 1953 by Dr. Jean OURY, an internationally renowned neuropsychiatrist. It receives 107 patients in full hospitalization, under the regime of free hospitalization, and 30 patients in day hospitalization. It is agreed. Located in the Loir et Cher, 15 km from the city of Blois, it has occupied since its creation a 19th century castle with its outbuildings, in a 23 hectares wooded park, with new pavilions added at different times (the last in 2011) due to the development of the activity.
